Our 'Try a Train' experience provides an ideal opportunity for those who lack confidence when travelling by train, to visit our stations and to experience a train journey.

By the end of the trip your group will have experienced a complete journey that will encourage further travel with confidence, without any anxieties or concerns. Groups sizes are kept small, usually 5 to 12 participants, including any staff.

The Try a Train programme consists of two parts:



Workshop at your school

(1.5 hrs) - planning your journey using timetables, maps and tickets. Using

Passenger Assist. Staying safe when you travel, including the British Transport Police's text number 61016 and how to use the Help Points.



Station visit and train

trip (4 hrs) - we will meet your group at your local station. We

will show them around the station facilities, show them how to buy a ticket using the ticket machines and demonstrate how to use the Help Points. We will then travel to a local station, stop for coffee* and return back to your station.

* Students will need to pay for their own refreshments.
